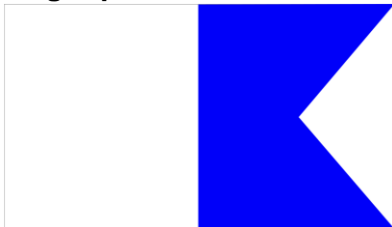
Shoreline Crossing Construction Works to commence at Gnoorea Point, Forty Mile Beach, Shire of Roebourne in January 2010

DrillTec, on behalf of Apache Energy Ltd, will be commencing the construction work for the shoreline crossing at Gnoorea Point, Forty Mile Beach in January 2010. Works will commence with site preparation within the designated shore-based marine facility by clearing of vegetation and installation of the drilling rig and associated infrastructure. A temporary water storage pond will also be constructed and a fence will be erected around the entire construction site. These activities will be carried out during daylight hours only.

Drilling under the shoreline is scheduled to commence by mid-February, when activities will switch to 24 hour operations.

Access to the boat ramp at Gnoorea Point or the surrounding camping areas will not be prevented, however, occasional diving activities up to approximately 3km offshore will necessitate a 500m exclusion zone around the diving site whenever the blue and white Flag Alpha is flying.

Apache advises, however, to take care when driving in the area as there will be increased road traffic and activity associated with the movement of materials and equipment to the construction site.

Temporary ablutions, comprising toilets with non-potable water handwashing facilities, will be available for public use, during daylight hours, at Gnoorea Point adjacent to the construction site.
